



## Development Committee

The Development Committee is the humanitarian and developmental part of the United Nations Student Association. We have partnerships with several NGOs in countries all around the world such as Madagascar, Nepal or India. We support our partners by organizing fundraising activities and by sending students abroad to conduct volunteer work. This year, a closer cooperation with local NGOs in Maastricht is planned to support projects such as sustainability or refugee projects. These aspects are meant to contribute to a mutual intercultural experience. In order for the Development Committee to achieve its goals, the committee is divided in two different teams: the Volunteering Network Team and the Fundraising Team.

**Fundraising:** organizes activities and events to create funds to financially support our Partner-NGOs. These events include pub quizzes and the yearly Charity Ball which is organized in cooperation with the Events Team.

**Volunteering Network:** maintains and expands our network of Partner-NGOs. It keeps close contact with the NGOs and follows their development. In addition, the team prepares the volunteers for their stay at our partner-NGOs. The preparation includes several workshops to make sure they can make the most of their stay.
